#### 1. Introduction

Central Rigging & Cranes Limited (In Liquidation) was put into Liquidation by order of the High Court at Auckland on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of April 2008 at 10.17am. Kenneth Peter Brown and Thomas Lee Rodewald were appointed Joint and Several Liquidators of the above named Company.
